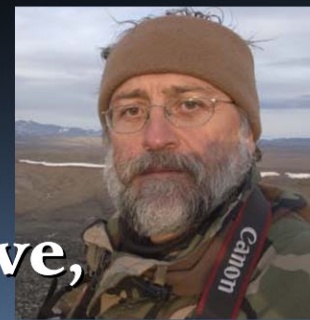


Speaker Vasiliy Baranyuk presents:

Snow Geese & Other Wildlife of the Wrangel Island Nature Reserve, Russia

Vasiliy Baranyuk, a Russian biologist, has studied this unique population of snow geese wildlife for the past 30 summers, with stretches as long as 87 days without seeing another human. The snow geese nest in an interior mountain valley and—like Antarctic penguins—flightless young walk an incredible distance (120 km) from the nesting colony to feeding areas near the sea. Vasiliy is also an accomplished photographer, with three decades of stunning pictures and videos.
